HAZARD ASSESSMENT to Determine Alternate Means of Access

An Aerial Lift Exit Permit is required whenever personnel must enter or exit an elevated work platform. When work is being performed at heights greater than 4 feet, fall protection is required.

- Can the task be performed from inside of the aerial lift?
- Is there another means of accessing the required elevation?
- Are other means of egress feasible?
- Can the aerial lift be exited through the gate?
- Can a proper anchor point be established prior to exiting the aerial lift? **(If NO, then the permit cannot be issued).**

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Fall Hazard – Harness and double lanyard must be used for fall protection.
- While exiting a man lift at elevation, 100% tie off must be maintained.
- Anchor points must be capable of withstanding a 5,000 lb. static load in the downward direction and be integrally sound.
- 100% Tie-Off at All Times – Working at heights without fall protection is an imminent danger safety violation and will be grounds for immediate removal from the facility.**
- Thermal Exposure
- Inadequate Clearance
- Electrical exposure
- Tripping Hazard
- Vehicle Hazard – Be alert for vehicular, construction, and pedestrian traffic in the vicinity. If man lift is positioned on the roadway, a flagman must be used to direct traffic. If the man lift is positioned on the side of the roadway, construction cones at the street-side corners of the lift shall be used. Spotters are required for maneuvering a man lift in and around process unit boundaries.
- Situate lift as close as possible to exit point.
